

Topic: Install Software from the Software Center (Campus PCs only)

Use the following instructions to install software on a campus-owned, Windows-based PC (e.g., faculty/staff computer). This is accomplished using the Microsoft Software Center. The following example will show how to install Blender via the Software Center.

Note: It is recommended to restart your PC prior to installing software from the Software Center to prevent any pending Windows updates from interfering with the installation.

1. Click on the **Start** button in the bottom left corner of your desktop.



2. Enter "Software Center" into the search window. Once the Software Center app shows in search results, click Open.



- **3.** Software Center opens to a listing of all software that is available for you to install. You can also search for the software you are looking for via the search box.
- 4. Once you have located the software you would like to install, click on the software name/icon
